

Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

Contract No JDA054.07.001\CN016: Upgrade of the Southern Gateway

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the Upgrade of the Southern Gateway.

The tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 4CE or higher.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the Tender Data.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works.

A compulsory site clarification meeting with representatives of the employer will take place on-site at the corner of Bertrams Road and Bezuidenhout Street on 30 November 2009, starting at 10:00.

Preference will be given to tenderers who have Black Equity Ownership, Black Executive Management and General Workforce Participation.

A non-refundable tender fee of R500.00 must be deposited into the JDA's bank account: ABSA Account No: 4054394825; Branch Code: 301305. Payment can be made by either an electronic funds transfer or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Johannesburg Development Agency. Proof of payment is required upon collection of the tender documents.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 12:00 noon from 20 November 2009.

Tenders must be placed in a sealed envelope and the tender description must be clearly written or typed on the envelope. The envelope must be deposited in the tender box at the Johannesburg Development Agency, Ground Floor, 3 President Street, The Bus Factory, Johannesburg.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and/or late tenders will not be accepted.

The closing date and time for receipt of tenders is 12:00 on Friday, 11 December 2009.

Tenders must only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. The retyping of the tender document is not permitted.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The JDA's selection of qualifying tenders will be at the JDA's sole discretion and will be final. The JDA does not bind itself to accept any particular tender. Correspondence will only be entered into with the successful tenderers.
