

# Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

## Construction of Section 4 BRT Trunk Route along Empire Road between Jan Smuts Avenue (km 0.0) and Victoria Avenue (km 1.1)

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the conversion of the existing Empire Road, between Jan Smuts Avenue and Victoria Avenue to accommodate BRT-type vehicles, including the construction of one BRT station platform.

The tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 8 or higher at the tender closing time. Joint Ventures are eligible to submit tenders, provided that they satisfy the criteria stated in the tender data.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in the CE class of construction works.

Preference will be given to tenderers who have Black Equity Ownership, Black Executive Management and General Workforce participation.

A non-refundable fee of R1000.00 must be deposited into the JDA bank account, ABSA Account Number: 4054394825, Branch Code: 301305. Payment can be made either by an electronic funds transfer or by a bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Johannesburg Development Agency. Proof of payment is required on collection of the tender documents.

**The physical address for collection of tender documents is: Johannesburg Development Agency, The Bus Factory, 3 President Street, Newtown 2000. Documents may be collected during working hours after 12:00 from Wednesday, 15 July 2009.**

A compulsory site clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the JDA Offices, The Bus Factory, 3 President Street, Johannesburg on Thursday, 29 July 2009 starting at 10:00, after which a visit to the site will take place. Tenderers will be registered for attendance.

**The closing date and time for the receipt of tenders is 12:00 on 14 August 2009. Telegraphic, telephone, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.**

Tenders must only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. The retyping of the tender document is not permitted.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the tender data.

The JDA's selection of qualifying tenders will be at the JDA's sole discretion and will be final. The JDA does not bind itself to accept any particular tender and correspondence will only be entered into with the successful tenderer.
